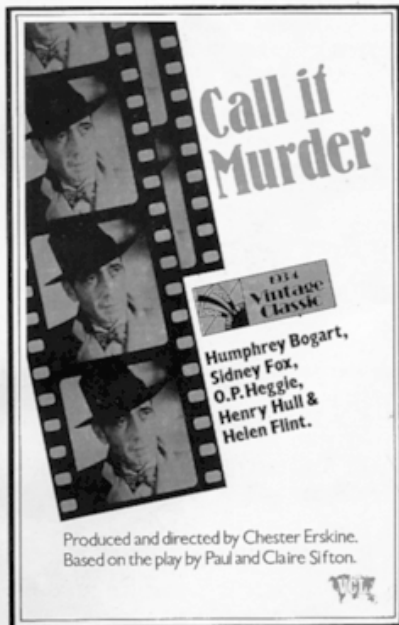

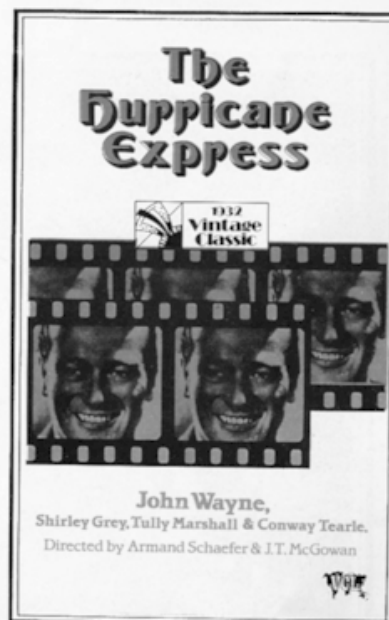
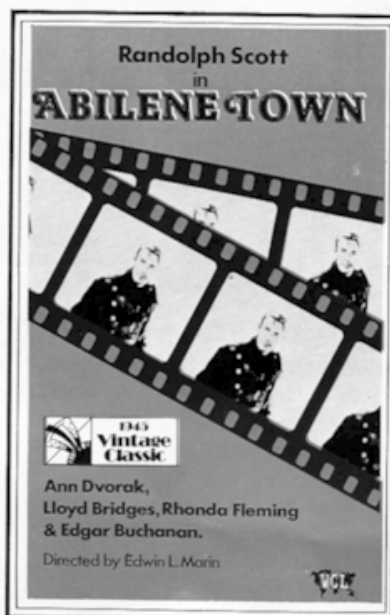
ABILENE TOWN ▼
